

# MAMRE-ABBOTTS- ALDINGTON ROAD UPGRADES PROJECT

## PROJECT OVERVIEW

**The Mamre-Abbotts-Aldington Road Upgrades is a crucial infrastructure project in the Western Sydney Employment Area, targeting key intersections within the Mamre Road Precinct (MRP).** The project is designed to meet the increasing industrial and residential demands, particularly the projected growth in freight and commuter traffic, while enhancing road safety, reducing traffic congestion, and improving transport efficiency by upgrading both the Mamre Road and Abbotts Road intersections, as well as Aldington Road.

These upgrades will ensure the road network can accommodate the projected growth in freight and commuter traffic while supporting local economic

expansion. The MRP covers over 850 hectares of land and is expected to generate 5,200 construction jobs and 17,000 ongoing jobs, making it a major industrial hub for the Western Sydney region.

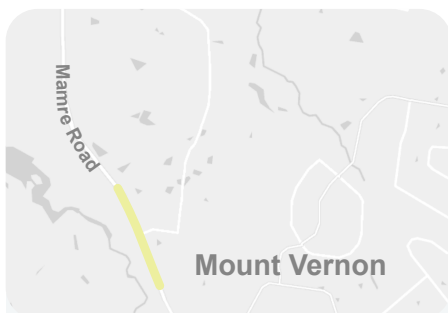
### Why this project is critical

### Mamre/Abbotts Road Intersection Upgrade

### Aldington and Abbotts Road Upgrade, Phase 1

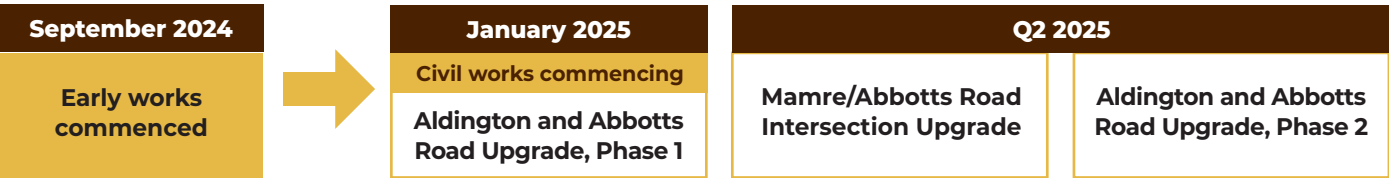


Road widening and realignment, new traffic signals, and safer pedestrian crossings will be implemented in two phases to meet future transport needs.

Water sprays and other mitigation measures will be implemented to reduce the impact of dust and noise on the surrounding community. Work will be restricted to specific hours, ensuring that disruption is minimised for residents and businesses.

### Environmental protections

All construction activities will adhere to strict environmental guidelines. This includes managing erosion, suppressing dust, and protecting local flora and fauna. Post-construction landscaping will restore and enhance the local environment, blending the new infrastructure with the surrounding area.
